Policy – Environmental management

Background

The Print Handicapped Radio of ACT Inc ('Radio 1RPH') aims to ensure that it minimises, in its operation and administration, harm to the environment.

Purpose

This policy sets out how Radio 1RPH will work to achieve a high standard of environmental care and responsibility. This will be achieved by taking all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent or minimise harm to the environment, while noting that the station operates within severe financial constraints.

Policy

In seeking to minimise its environmental impact Radio 1RPH will:

- ensure that Radio 1RPH complies with all applicable environmental legislation and regulations
- provide training where appropriate, to staff and volunteers, on how to minimise adverse environmental impacts
- consider environmental matters in all business planning and risk management
- implement procedures to verify and review Radio 1RPH's environmental performance
- reduce, re-use and recycle waste products wherever appropriate.

Radio 1RPH acknowledges that everyone associated with the organisation has a role to play in achieving these environmental goals and staff and volunteers are expected to comply with any measures implemented to improve the station's environmental performance.
